Humans are the most special among all the living things. Human beings are not only regarded as good by God, but also possess the image of God.

As for the children who think they are winners, they may have won the "confidence" and the desire to "return". However, if I think I'm a winner, God's view may not be the same.

Take the competition as an example. If the "winner" doesn't prepare carefully and doesn't do his best during the competition, what else can he get besides winning the medal? If he changes his opponent, he may not even have a medal.

And if the "winners" just show off and forget the God gives people power, isn't this just arrogance? And too much emphasis on winning or losing, when he really "loses", can he really bear it? — Won the medal, but lose the mentality to learn, is this still being a winner?

On the contrary, even if you can't get a medal in the game, as long as you have the right attitude, prepare carefully before the game, and go all out during the game; underestimate the victory and defeat, just seek to break through yourself; whenever you make progress, give glory to the God who gives people the ability; There has been progress in methods, technology and performance-is this still a "failure"?

In the author's teaching career, I have encountered two types of students with low confidence from time to time: the first type of students are regarded as losers by others, so they doubt themselves; the second type of students regard themselves as losers and therefore give up.

'In order to encourage them, when answering the first type of students, the author would say something like this: "Do you know? You are the mighty creation of God, how can you be the powerless? How can you be useless? Maybe someone got it wrong! "

When answering the second type of students, the author will say something like: "Fortunately you know me. Please remember that you are the mighty creation of God. I will prove this to you slowly. I will not be wrong. Please don't underestimate yourself."

Everyone must take good care of themselves and their children. "Being optimistic about" the child, and helping the child to "be optimistic about" themselves; looking for a way to build up the child, and helping the child find a way to build up themselves. Believe in God and "build up" children with Him, instead of "lowering" them, we are all incredible creations of God and God doesn't make mistakes.

May God give us wisdom!

Win In Quiet

'In this school year, the parents' service's has not been achieved. We have only completed the first stage of the parent sessions and the 6A course has only been run 3 times. The parent ministry and the student suspension were both affected by suspensions. How can I write an annual article! What can I write?

A person who normally spends about 1/3 of life in bed. If you are 90 years old and you will sleep for 30 years, do you feel it is wasted? It seems that you can't do anything when you sleep. But if you don't sleep, your body and spirit will not be recovered. Your body and mind will become unhealthy over a period of time. Even if you are awake, what can you do? Stopping for a rest is sometimes not negative. When one form is stopped, another form can be started, and stillness can have a positive and enterprising side.

There are "Periodical cicadas" (scientific name: Magicicada) living in nature mainly in North America. Its life cycle is 13 or 17 years, so it is also called 13-year cicada and 17-year cicada. The cicada eggs hatch into larvae, they burrow into the ground immediately. They spend most of their lives in the dark and stillness. During this period, they survived by sucking the sap of tree roots. After ten more years later, thousands of "Nymphs"* of the same race brake the ground at the same time, climbed onto the tree, and emerged (grow wings) within 4-6 weeks, mate, lay eggs, complete the life cycle and die.

Cicadas spend most of their lives in the ground without much action, mainly to avoid predators, which is similar to the situation in which we stay home to avoid the epidemic. Cicadas are not doing nothing in the ground. They suck the sap that nourishes life every day to keep their bodies in its best condition and grow slowly but continuously. Although it can't be observed, everything is only going on in the dark, it can be seen on the day of them breaking from the ground. To climb up to the dense foliage of the big tree as soon as possible on that day. It will have the opportunity to complete the most important reproduction task of their life. The claws that have not climbed in more than ten years will have sufficient strength with the nutrients they have absorbed. The brilliance of life can be revealed, often from the hidden days, not idleness in the static, not light effort.

Rather than waiting boringly for the resumption of classes, it is better to learn from the cicadas. To find out all beneficial information on the Internet, like a cicada sucking the juice of tree roots day and night. So that the body will not stop growing and mature day by day, wait for the day when the ground is broken. The children once again gathered together with their familiar little companions. When the beautiful day come, everyone shows not weak limbs and blunt responses, but a lot of lively little lives grew. Parents can help to find a suitable online information for their children to absorb the nourishment of their brains and minds. Parents can also listen to more sermons online to bring the soul closer to the "Father of Lights" so that they can gain power and stand in the darkness when storm clouds rise. You can also triumph over discouragement and laziness.

**Nymphs are a form of incompletely metamorphic insects that skip the pupal state. The nymph is very close to the adult except that it has no arms and genitals.*

The life cycle of most of the insects can avoid overlapping with the life cycle of natural enemies. If the life cycle of the natural enemy of a cicada in 17 years is 5 years, it will take $17 \times 5 = 85$ years for the two to meet each other head-on. Assuming that the 13-year cicada competes with the 17-year cicada at the same place, it takes $13 \times 17 = 221$ years to meet for the first time. In 13 and 17 cicadas, there were more than 20 ethnic groups that grew up in different locations, each with a different maturity year. This is the ingenious design of the creator.
