Although it seemed that there were not many choices for the teaching aids, they had another discovery. From children's paintings, building Lego toys, reading storybooks, sharing their thoughts with teachers, and following the physical rhythm of the video, we can see their inner world and lively side of their work. We can see the joy and satisfaction on their faces. Especially when they did it themselves. Thank you teachers for your preparation, so that the children had the opportunity to show up themselves. This was an inspiration for teachers too.

Some teachers were on sick leave due to the diagnosis. The children would ask them during this period: "Have you recovered yet?" The substitute teacher used the video function to let the children meet with the

class teacher. They told the class teacher, "I miss you so much! When will you come back?" The scene was very beautiful and heartwarming. It is better to go to school, and ask the Lord to lead us.

After entering K3, we found out that Yat Yin liked to praise himself a lot. Such as "I'm a genius", "I'm the best", "Am I good?" and so on. It may be because in his eyes, whether at home or at school, he is already a "big brother", so he will boast or seek for our approval or appreciation for almost everything he does. This semester's character education is "Humble". (Sighing that God's timetable is always just right!) I once read an article on parenting: "Everything has three situations: excessive, insufficient, and intermediate. "Excessive" and "Inadequate" often destroy moral character." How to teach children humility is not really an easy thing! (pat on shoulder)

Once after school, he said that he wanted to take the bus home, and we had to go through the shopping mall to get to the bus stop. There are several doors to push open along the way. Yat Yin volunteered to open the door and said, "I'm a 'big boy', am I the strongest?" When he came to the next door, he said, "I'll hold the door for you to pass, isn't it the most polite thing?" I knew that he wanted compliments from me, but I smiled and said nothing. When we came to the last door, an elder needed to pass by, and Yat Yin pushed the door open to let the elder pass first. The elder honored him, "Little boy, you are really good and polite!" and gave him a "like" with a thumbs up. He was so excited and said: "Mom, did you hear that? An elder praised me!" I said, "I saw it! People will see what you did! Others can "see" from your behavior, but not what you said to boast yourself. You must continue to work hard!" After the door-pushing incident, Yat Yin seemed to say less of those "boasting" words. Instead, he has praised and encouraged others.

Children know themselves from the evaluation of their parents since they are sensible. Parents please be the mirror of your children; let them see the beautiful and unique version of themselves from your eyes. Instead of constantly labeling our children negatively, we should see their strengths and learn to accept our own imperfections. Humility is the fuel for growth. Let us see the world through "Humble" glasses with our children, so that we can embrace the whole world.

Today, Chun Hung and I visited Snoopy's World, which is not that far from the school (Snoopy's World, which is a small theme park located on the third floor of Shatin New Town Plaza).



Snoopy's World is the first Snoopy-themed Park and has free admission, and loved by children of all ages. Now because of the epidemic situation, the flow of people is controlled; be aware that it is not open to the public on rainy days.

If you do not know how to get to Snoopy's World, it is located on the same floor as the exit of **Sha Tin Station**. If you go straight from Sha Tin Station to the end of the New Town Plaza, you will see a big **Snoopy and Woodstock** sunbathing on the roof. Before you enter, there are cartoon characters welcoming you at the door. When you enter the big house, it is a **doghouse**. You will see a big **antique TV**, and Charlie is sitting and watching TV. There is a very gorgeous electric **light** on the TV. Through this large doghouse, you will enter the world of Snoopy. On the right hand side after entering, you will see an **American-style yellow school bus**. In front of the bus, several children are welcoming you to board the bus. I believe that this bus is used to send children and cartoon characters to school.

There is also a "**Canoe Ride**" in the park. The only amusement ride in Snoopy's World and very attractive. You need to spend some time to line up before boarding. The adult can accompany by the child if it is needed. The whole journey takes around 2-3minutes. You can see different characters all around you, e.g. Snoopy fishing, spacemen, etc.

There is a **playground** in the middle of the park, which is a must-play attraction for children. You can play with the slides, climb, and pass three levels, etc. While the children are playing, parents can rest on the dog bone bench next to it and watch the children.

There are many different characters and spots in Snoopy's World for children to explore and take pictures. If you have time, you can bring your children to play and discover the interesting stories of Snoopy and his friends in different corners.

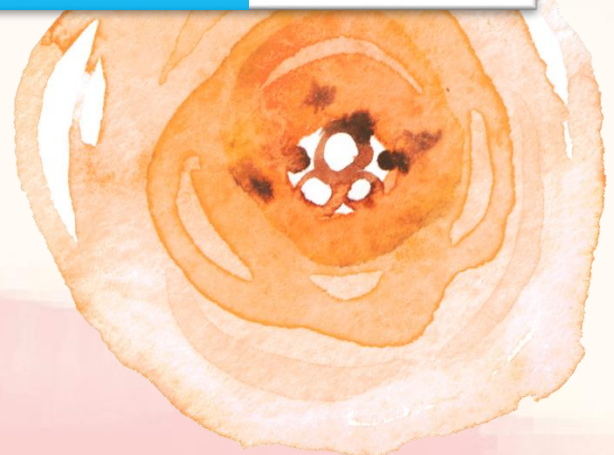

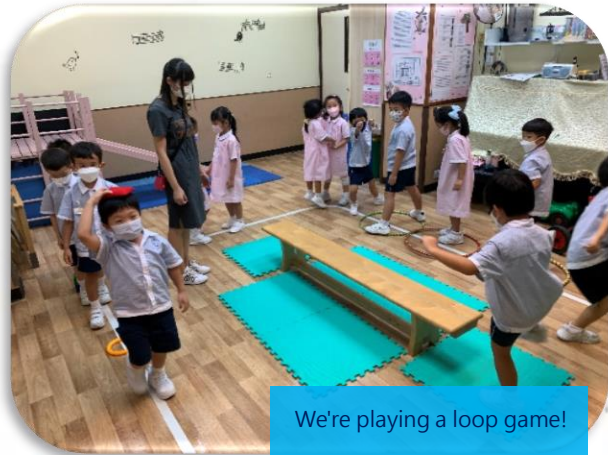

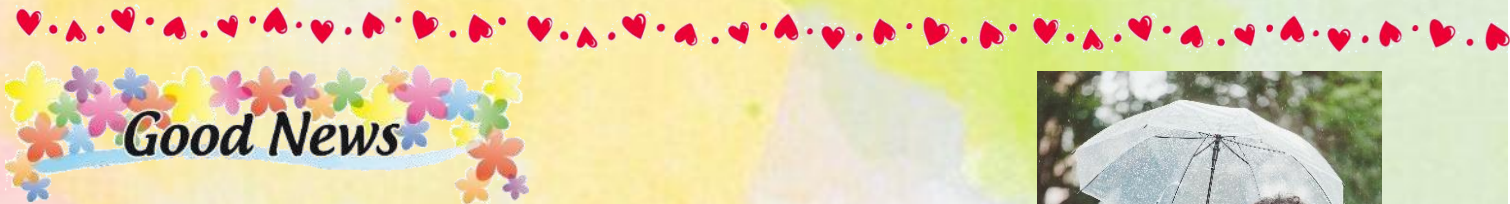
