Objectives of Activities

- 1. To learn about the Mid-Autumn Festival, a traditional Chinese festival through stories and pictures.
- 2. To be able to follow the routines when participating group activities.
- 3. To cultivate beauty and creativity by appreciating lanterns.
- 4. To cultivate a sense of responsibility through activities such as caring for peers and lanterns.

Summary of Activities

At the Mid-Autumn Festival Lantern Festival, children brought back parent-child made lanterns, they held lanterns, walked freely around the campus, shared and appreciated with each other. During the activity, sand painting videos of the Mid-Autumn Festival and Mid-Autumn Festival songs were also arranged to cultivate beauty and creativity through appreciation of lanterns.

Children also carried out drawing activities related to the Mid-Autumn Festival in groups, with K1 class children making rice ball glay, K2 class children using traditional cake molds to make flour mooncake drawings, and K3 class children using light clay mixed colours to make icy mooncakes, so that the children could have a preliminary understanding of Chinese culture, art and traditional foods.

In addition, we also invited parent volunteers to share stories with children with the theme of the Mid-Autumn Festival, so that children can understand the content of traditional Chinese festivals.
