Farm Visit

Objectives of Activities

1. To introduce children to different crops and increase their knowledge about them.
2. To provide children with the experience of being little farmers and understanding the effort and process involved in food production.
3. To cultivate a sense of environmental stewardship and appreciation for nature in children.

Summary of Activities

The activity led the K3 children to the Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups Organic Farm, where they visited various facilities including a small garden, composting area, fish pond, and crop display area. During the visit, the tour guide provided explanations about organic knowledge. The children had the opportunity to use their sense of sight, touch, and smell to learn about seeds, soil, fertilizers, and pest control. This multi-sensory exploration of nature allowed children to experience the wonders of the natural world.

During the visit, children had the opportunity to step into the organic farm and learn about different crops, the work of farmers, and the growing environment of plants. Apart from gaining knowledge, K3 children became little farmers themselves as they engaged in hands-on farming activities. This experience allowed them to experience the joy of organic farming and developed a preliminary understanding of it. It also helped foster a sense of appreciation for food and a caring attitude towards nature.
